CERTIFIED ARBORISTS

From the very beginning, Nathaniel Sperry was committed to being an industry leader. He was one of the first in the area to become an ISA Certified Arborist and has been awarded Oregon Arboriculturist of the Year. That tradition of excellence continues today and every employee is encouraged to become an ISA Certified Arborist. A Certified Arborist is a tree care professional who has been trained in the science and art of planting, maintaining, and caring for trees. Certification is awarded by the International Society of Arboriculture (ISA) after passing an exam that tests knowledge in tree biology, pruning, soil management, pest control, risk assessment and tree preservation.

Sperry Tree Care is proud to have 10 ISA Certified Arborists on staff.

To become an ISA Certified Arborist, an individual must have:

- A minimum of **three years** of full-time experience in arboriculture or a related field, or a degree in arboriculture, forest, horticulture or landscape architecture.
- Passed the ISA Certified Arborist exam.
- Continued education to maintain the certification

Certified Arborists follow industry standards for tree care to ensure the health, safety and longevity of trees. Following industry standards helps homeowners to reduce liability risks and many cities require compliance for construction projects or public space maintenance.

Our team has enjoyed looking back at where we started, but our eyes are also firmly on the future and how innovative technology, sustainable practices and developing an expert workforce will benefit our customers now and in the future.

TECHNOLOGY

The use of Geographic Information Systems (GIS) for tree inventory. A tree inventory has information about individual trees so that property owners can track the species, condition and age of trees as well as the care history. This is a particularly useful tool for large properties like parks, HOA's, Apartment Complexes and more.

Tomography is a diagnostic tool that can be used to reconstruct the internal structure of a tree using external measurements. Like medical tomography (CT scan), it allows the technician to get a view of the inside of the tree. This is particularly useful if any kind of rot is suspected.

CONVENIENT ANNUAL CARE PLANS

We are in the process of launching annual care that will take your tree care maintenance off your to-do list and puts it on ours. When the time

comes for your annual service, our team will contact you to start the process and schedule an estimate appointment. Annual Care Plan participants will also receive priority scheduling. Call to learn more about this free service and how to join.



SUSTAINABLE PRACTICES

We are truly a company that cares for trees. When a tree has reached the end of its life and needs to be removed, we are there for that. But we are also looking towards the future and how we can be part of increasing the number of trees that we have in our community.
